- **ORGANISED NATIONAL SEMINARS, INTER RELIGIOUS CELEBRATION AND FESTIVALS**

Started Celebrating National and Religious festivals together with the representatives of all religions and people from different walks of life from 1999 onwards. Celebration of Christmas, Easter, the Month of Ramayana, Eid al-Fitr, Diwali, Gurunanak Jayanthi, Onam and other religious and cultural festivals created an ambience of mutual respect, acceptance and togetherness in society.

Following these celebrations, Muslims started celebrating Christmas at Al Ameen schools in Edappally, Kochi and other places in Kerala. Believers of Satya Sai Bava also started celebrating Christmas after attending the programs at Chavara Cultural Centre Kochi.

"I am here to "CELEBRATE YOUR FAITH" without losing mine.

I am here to "UPHOLD MY RELIGION" without hurting yours.

I am here to "APPRECIATE OUR DIFFERENCES" without giving up our uniqueness."

HARMONY (SOUHARDHAM) CLUBS IN SCHOOLS IN KERALA

Being the Secretary to the KCBC Dialogue and Ecumenism commission, organised HARMONY (SOUHARDHAM) CLUBS in association with Deepika Children's League (DCL), and Kannur Peace Foundation to promote peace and harmony and mutual respect and acceptance among students of different religions in Schools and colleges in Kerala. The further objectives were to educate children To BE FAITHFUL to their own religions and To RESPECT other Religions, To ACCEPT friends of all religions and To APPRECIATE and CELEBRATE the differences without losing their own identity, uniqueness and Faith.

2008 – 2015

Chavara Fest - A Cultural festival of traditional art forms and cuisines irrespective of cast religion and language

Initiated Chavara Fest – a unique 7 days cultural fiesta for immortalising traditional art forms set in rustic ambience, bringing together families irrespective of cast, creed and religion to savour traditional tastes and enjoy ethnic folklore in Kerala for the first time.

2000 – 2004

KARMODAYA - an initiative to empower the auto/ taxi drivers in Munnar, Kerala

Initiated a movement for the promotion of Peace and Harmony and for the Sustainable development of auto/ taxi drivers in Munnar, Kerala.

Drivers were given regular training in Spoken English, Grooming and Etiquette. Nature preservation, cleanliness, Legal awareness classes, HIV/AIDS awareness campaign, and traffic rules and regulations have also been given. This, in turn, helped auto and taxi drivers adopt a positive attitude towards passengers, especially tourists, and enhance their earnings as well. Then later the village Korandakad Munnar, Kerala, became a liquor-free village – through theatre, art and awareness campaigns. Celebrated festivals of all religions together with everyone.

2011 – CURRENT

CHAVARA INSPIRE CHARITABLE SOCIETY - For inborn HIV/ AIDS children

*Initiated a charitable society working for the benefit of the Socially Ostracised, especially **children living with HIV and Visually Challenged**. Chavara Inspire has supported 300 children living with HIV by providing them with scholarships, mental support by way of personality & motivational training, support for their medical needs, construction houses, providing finance for the repair of houses, providing employment and much more.*

The Visually challenged community was well taken care of by providing ways for livelihood to them. They are given life skills and employability training and provided with employment.

1991 – 1994

A MOVEMENT AGAINST CAMPUS POLITICS IN KERALA

Fought against Campus Politics while studying at Union Christian College, Aluva, Kerala 1991-1994 and established the first Anti-Campus Politics organisation. This movement won the court verdict against campus politics in schools in 1996 and later in colleges.

(Anti-Strick Movement started at UC College Aluva and was later merged with Vidyabhyasa Suraksha Samithi initiated by Guru Nitya Chaithanya Yathi, Prof. S Gupthan Nair and Satyavan Kottarakkara).
